Biographical/Historical Note

The Basilica of Old St. Patrick's Cathedral is the second oldest Catholic Church in New York City. Its construction was began in 1809 and completed in 1815. The church still stands at its original location at 263 Mulberry Street in Manhattan. During its years as the official cathedral, Old St. Patrick's witnessed many historic events. Bishop Connolly established St. Patrick's School in 1817. The old cathedral was home to John Hughes, the first archbishop of New York. The first American Cardinal John Cardinal McCloskey was invested in 1875 at the old cathedral. The old cathedral was completely destroyed in a fire in 1866 and was rebuilt in 1868 on the site of the fire. Old St. Patrick's served as the Archdiocese's of New York cathedral until the opening of the new St. Patrick's Cathedral in 1879.

Since May 25, 1879, Old St. Patrick's as served the archdiocese as a parish church. Old St. Patrick's has had numerous immigrant groups as its parishioners. In the early years, the church served a church for a German and French population. An Irish population then dominated, followed by an Italian population. Today the church serves a Hispanic and Chinese community that lives near the church. The constant change in the church's community reflects the change in immigrant communities in New York City.

On March 17, 2010 Pope Benedict XVI designated Old St. Patrick's a basilica.

Scope & Content Note

The Basilica of Old St. Patrick's Cathedral Collection consists of documents, newspapers, and photographs from the years 1817-2009. This material documents the history and function of Old St. Patrick's Cathedral as well as the St. Patrick's School. The collection has been divided into nine series that reflect the different functions and types of materials found at Old St. Patrick's. The type of material ranges from newspaper articles, bulletins, administrative documents, correspondence, photographs, and blueprints. A scrapbook containing letters from 1885 and 1891 has been taken apart for preservation reasons so that the letters can be easily accessed. Oversized material in the collection consists of photographs, newspapers, and blueprints and were separated and placed in appropriate housing for materials of that size.

Series I: Administration contains documents that reflect the history of the institution as well as additional records, correspondence, and publications that outline its functions. Series II: Building contains materials that deal with the construction and upkeep of the building. Documents pertaining to specific furniture, such as the organ, and blueprints of the cemetery are also found in this series. Series III: Finance contains correspondence and reports from the 1930s, 1970s, and 1980s, that discuss the finances of the church.

Series IV: School has some material relating to the school at St. Patrick's, such as a history of the school, a graduation program, and other files. Additional materials about the school can be

found in a separate collection, 014.001: Old St. Patrick's School. Series V: Events documents any events that were held at the Church, such as centennial celebrations and priest jubilees. Promotional material such as programs and invitations can be found in this series. Series VI: Photographs contains photos from numerous events held at Old St. Patrick's, as well as photos of the interior and exterior of the building, and photos of parishioners from over the years.

Series VII: Newspapers contains an assortment of newspaper clippings and complete newspapers such as articles from the *New York Post* and *New York Magazine*. *Harpers Weekly* and *Frank Leslie's Illustrated* newspapers from the 19th century are also included in this series. Series VIII: Subject Files contain files on different people such as pastor of the church, Monsignor Marinacci, and topics such as the history of the Irish in New York City. Series IX: Scrapbook contains the pages of scrapbook that documents the 1885 Consecration of Old St. Patrick's and the 1891 Silver Jubilee of Father John F. Kearney. The binding of the scrapbook was falling apart and therefore the pages were separated from it. The order of the scrapbook has been maintained.
